Ordinance 111 Fire Dept Mandate Minimum Training Requirements – minor change.

Summary of changes to adopt:

1. Remove “or serve Lackawaxen Township” in the first paragraph.
2. Replace the term fireman to firefighter and policeman to police, through-out the ordinance.
3. Add “Pike County Training Center” and remove college and replace with “ETA” to the last paragraph in section 4, to read as:

Class standards for this manual include but are not limited to the National Fire Academy, Pennsylvania State Fire Academy, Pike County Training Center, FEMA or any ETA approved course for emergency training within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
4. Add "Pike Basic Academy" to section 5, A. & B. as follows:
 - A. “Exterior Fire Fighter.” Essentials of Fire Fighting current edition at the time of the class. Individuals must complete the course curriculum for all modules 1, 2, 3 and/or Pike Basic Academy.
 - B. "Interior Fire Fighter." Essentials of Fire Fighting current edition at the time of the class. Individuals must complete the course curriculum for all modules 1, 2, 3 and 4. This includes completing the structural burn session at the end of module 4 and/or Pike Basic Academy.
5. Add “with an interior Firefighter Certificate” to section 9, as follows:

Any individual who is a Volunteer Firefighter, with an Interior Firefighter Certificate, for any Fire Department in Lackawaxen Township must complete F.A.S.T./R.I.T. which is a basic class as per described by the Academy and also F.A.S.T./R.I.T. advanced class as per described by the Academy.
6. Add a new section, number 16. Section 16.
Records

Initial records and yearly updated records should be submitted to the Township and kept on file at the Township building.
7. Add the following vehicles/watercraft to Appendix A: Engine/Pumper Class A, Support Vehicles, Engine/Pumper (less than class A), and Boat/Watercraft.

Section 4.03 Funding of Departments

Funding of the fire departments will be done using the fire tax set by township supervisors. Disbursements will be made following second class township code as specified here.

Required financial reporting and Township appropriations. In accordance with Section 1803 of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code and as required herein, all fire companies recognized shall annually submit to the Board of Supervisors a report of use of appropriated moneys for each completed year of operations before any further payments are made to the fire company for the current year in such sum(s) that in the opinion of said Board of Supervisors may be necessary in support of fire company facilities and training in accordance with Section 1803(a) of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code.
